The following items cause problems in the recycling process, so be sure to keep them out of your recycling.



Plastic bags and film



Bagged recycling



Large plastic items and toys



Plastic foam (Styrofoam™)



Electronics and batteries



Random metal items



Glass dishes, window glass, and ceramics



Pressurized cylinders (propane, helium, CO2)



#6 and black plastics



Containers that held hazardous products

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Paper plates, cups, napkins, straws, and utensils



Tanglers like electrical cords, holiday lights, and hoses
